**Meadowcrest Public School – SCC Meeting Minutes**

**SCC update**

Vandermeer Nursery Fundraiser:

Action: Consider additional opportunities for remaining funds (about \$10,000) (e.g. more activities for children to play with in the yard/on the field)

- About \$200 cost – demonstrate support for staff

Jessie Gaudreau, Brian Rees and Principal Marchand to co-ordinate

Voucher allocated to each teacher for classroom use (21 total):

- \$100 voucher per teacher; each Kindergarten pair receives \$200 (receipts provided by May 29 to Darlene)

Motion: Jessie Gaudreau; seconded Lisa Miller

- Elphie to create voucher and thank you card for teachers
- Vice Principal O'Connor to send Elphie list of names
- To be distributed as soon as possible

Cards and Notepads (update from Lisa Ramsden):

- Found a local company – company able to create canvases and greeting cards – deemed not profitable at this time
