Review of Minutes (Brian and Lisa)

Overview of last year's accomplishments:

- Last meeting was held on February 2020 (prior to COVID-19 shutdown)
- Vandermeer Nursery & Garden Centre fundraiser \$1,500 raised
- Family Skate \$200 raised
- End-of-year dance put on hold
- Scientists in the School some classes participated prior to shutdown
- SCC funds provided for Grade 8 Graduation annual contribution of \$500 budgeted Action: an overage that needs to be discussed
- Funds allocated towards teachers/staff to thank them for their support

Treasurer's Report (Brian and Lisa)

- \$11,000 currently in SCC account **Action:** consider fundraising options for next meeting (e.g. virtual)
- Healthy Hunger biggest source of revenue Healthy Hunger will not be offered at this time

Administrator's Report (David and Wendy)

- Introduced new Vice Principal, Wendy Pokupec
- About 14,000 students registered for virtual program in DDSB for Meadowcrest, currently 25 per cent of the student population opted for the virtual program (currently about 300 students registered for in-classroom learning)
- Principal David Marchand provided an overview of COVID protocols implemented in school (as per Ministry of Health and DDSB regulations); e.g. masking, cohorts at recess, main touchpoints cleaned daily, ensure sanitizers filled, no visitor's allowed in building (unless necessary) - Administration currently developing procedures to account for changes in weather
- Protocols re: sick students: families asked to complete the daily COVID selfassessment – if something cannot be answered positively, it is best to keep the student home; Administration is following Durham Public Health guidelines; there is a room for students to stay (separate from other students) if they are unwell – it is sanitized after each use; TeleHealth and family doctor are great resources if parents have specific questions
- Principal Marchand thanked Meadowcrest families for their support
- Each classroom equipped with Google Classroom please familiarise yourself with this platform; require an OEN to access (noted on your child's report card)
- Progress Report November
- School Group set up on the Remind application
